The Law expects you fulfil the new Occupational Health & Safety Act 2007 and Fire Risk Reduction Rule 2007. Do you know if you have a problem in this area? We can help you find out.

Factories and Other Places of Work Act (Fire Risk Reduction) Rules 2007 The subsidiary legislation has gone further in giving orders to the occupiers such as:-

- (i) Formation of fire fighting teams
- (ii) Training on fire safety
- (iii) Fire drills
- (iv) Fire safety policy
- (v) Fire safety audit
